**Numbers 6:24-26**

## Deuteronomy 28:3-8

<sup>3</sup> Your towns and your fields will be blessed. <sup>4</sup> Your children and your crops will be blessed. The offspring of your herds and flocks will be blessed. <sup>5</sup> Your fruit baskets and breadboards will be blessed. <sup>6</sup> Wherever you go and whatever you do, you will be blessed. <sup>7</sup> “The Lord will conquer your enemies when they attack you. They will attack you from one direction, but they will scatter from you in seven! <sup>8</sup> “The Lord will guarantee a blessing on everything you do and will fill your storehouses with grain. The Lord your God will bless you in the land he is giving you.

## Numbers 6:24-26

<sup>24</sup> The Lord bless you and keep you; <sup>25</sup> The Lord make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you; <sup>26</sup> The Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.

## Exodus 34:29

<sup>29</sup> When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God.

## Acts 6:15

<sup>15</sup> Everyone seated in the council stared at Stephen, and they saw that his face was radiant, just like an angel's.

## Exodus 34:29-35

<sup>29</sup> When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God. <sup>30</sup> Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him. <sup>31</sup> But Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and Moses talked with them. <sup>32</sup> Afterward all the people of Israel came near, and he commanded them all that the Lord had spoken with him on Mount Sinai.

## Exodus 34:29-35

<sup>33</sup> And when Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil over his face. <sup>34</sup> Whenever Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he would remove the veil, until he came out. And when he came out and told the people of Israel what he was commanded, <sup>35</sup> the people of Israel would see the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face was shining. And Moses would put the veil over his face again, until he went in to speak with him.

## 2 Corinthians 3:16-18

<sup>16</sup> But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. <sup>17</sup> For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. <sup>18</sup> So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord, who is the Spirit, makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

## 2 Timothy 4:8

<sup>8</sup> And now the prize awaits me—the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of His return. And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to His appearing.
